2010 Custodian of the Year: **RULES-AWARD PROCESS-APPLICATION**

For the 3rd straight year, the **N.S.C.A.** will award a \$500.00 scholarship. This Scholarship will be given in the name of the Custodian of the Year winner AND the **N.S.C.A.** The scholarship will be awarded to a successful 2011 scholarship applicant at the School of the Custodian of the Year's choice.

Rules for Custodian of the Year Consideration

- Must be a facility custodian at time of application to qualify
- May apply yourself or it can be done anonymously for you
- Must be a current paid member of the **N.S.C.A.**
 - Last day to enroll for membership will be March 24th 2010
 - Annual Membership Dues of \$35.00 may be sent with application and MUST be received by the **N.S.C.A.** on or before 3/24/2010
 - Annual Membership dues, and Applications will be accepted at the Annual Trade show on 3/24/2010, in Grand Island NE
- Must attend at least 1 **N.S.C.A.** event in past 3 years (trade show or school)
 - Last event qualification opportunity: Trade Show in Grand Island 3/24/2010
- Must submit completed application and at least 1 professional letter of recommendation to the **N.S.C.A.** on or before 5/3/2010
- The **N.S.C.A.** committee will narrow ALL applicants down to 2 finalists, and will visit these facilities before making final determination of award winner
- This years award will be presented 6/7/2010 at the **N.S.C.A.** Annual Banquet
- Custodian of the Year Award winner will declare their School of choice before 9/1/2010
- Scholarship will be awarded in winner's AND **N.S.C.A.**'s name to that school at commencement exercises at the conclusion of the 2010-2011 School year.
 - There will be a rigorous application/award process for the scholarship recipient
 - Scholarship consideration will involve an application process similar to the Custodian of the year Application
 - Scholarship consideration will include a 2 page essay/report on the responsibilities & impact of their school Custodian on their school and community environment
 - Scholarship Applications and all supporting documents will be due to the **N.S.C.A.** on or before 4/1/2011
 - Scholarship Check will be written to the winners choice of secondary education institution, checks will not be written to individual
 - Additional/Final Scholarship application details will be unveiled at the 2010 Custodian of the Year announcement
